Major Scott A. Schneider is the Commander, Detachment 1, 21st Contracting Squadron, 21st Space Wing, Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado. He commands a geographically separated, joint AFSPC/DLA/USAFE unit at the U.S. Embassy in Copenhagen, Denmark. He provides contracting airlift, sealift, architectural and engineering, construction and operational and maintenance services in support of Thule AB, Greenland. He is a key advisor to the US Ambassador to Denmark, Department of State and Air Force Space Command officials on all Air Force matters tied to Denmark, Greenland and Northern Europe. He leads the acquisition support for military operations at Thule AB, (\$934M contract life cycle value), upholding international agreements with Denmark, while positively representing the Air Force to International partners.



Maj. Schneider is a native of Rose City, MI and was commissioned in April 2006 through the Reserve Officer Training Corp program upon graduation from Michigan Technological University in Houghton, Michigan. He has served in a variety of contracting positions at the base and systems levels and is certified Acquisition Professional Development in Contracting Level III and Acquisition Professional Development in Program Management Level I. He has deployed once in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom and twice to Operation Enduring Freedom.

Prior to this assignment, Capt Schneider served as the contracting officer for the Hard Target Munitions Branch, Air Force Life Cycle Management Center, Eglin AFB, FL. In this position, he was responsible for development and the acquisition of supplies and services in support of a \$1B hard target munitions portfolio.
